Academic Excellence Scholarship (AES) Information Sheet

General Information:

- ⇒ Wisconsin's top high school seniors are awarded the Academic Excellence Scholarship (AES). They must be citizens or permanent residents of the US and residents of Wisconsin.
- ⇒ By **February 25th**, the high school must choose the senior with the highest cumulative grade point average as of the end of fall semester. High schools with enrollments above 500 may award more than one scholarship.
- ⇒ The AES provides up to \$2250 per year for tuition at a Wisconsin college or university for up to four years. The scholarship must be used at a University of Wisconsin, An Independent College or University, or at a Wisconsin Technical College. When HEAB receives the names of the AES recipients, a form is e-mailed to the student asking for the name of the college they will attend. HEAB notifies the college of the student's AES, and the college and HEAB jointly disburse the money and apply it directly to the student's tuition. We also send a presentational certificate for you to give your AES winners.

Information about this year's nomination form:

- ⇒ You provide the enrollment number as of the third Friday in September for grades 9-12.
- ⇒ We no longer need SSNs on the school nomination form.
- ⇒ You provide a current e-mail address for students. **Do not use school-affiliated addresses.**

- ⇒ The scholarship recipient(s) you list should be the student(s) with the highest cumulative GPAs regardless of whether or not they plan to use the AES in-state. If you have a unique question about this, please contact me.
- ⇒ For unweighted grading systems, you may list the students with the next highest GPAs (3.8 or higher) as alternates.
- ⇒ For weighted grading systems where an A may be worth more grade points in some courses than in others, you may list students with the next highest GPAs as alternates.
- ⇒ Please enter the cumulative GPA for each student as it is shown on your official high school transcript
- ⇒ We require ACT scores in addition to GPA for statistical purposes only.

Important Notes:

- ⇒ Please submit names exactly as the student wishes to have their name on the certificate. We no longer issue corrected certificates.
- ⇒ Alert all recipients and alternates of their AES status as early as possible and let them know they will be receiving important information via e-mail.
- ⇒ Please ask students for **current e-mail addresses**. Do not use any school affiliated addresses e.g. ending in .k12.wi.us or .org.

- ⇒ **Nominations cannot be changed once they are received at HEAB and student e-mails have been sent. Errors are handled by the high school.**
