WISCONSIN STATE STUDENT FINANCIAL AID DATA FOR 2006-07**

The series of exhibits in this Board Report present 2006-07 academic year student financial aid information for Wisconsin resident undergraduates. The colleges and universities within the four different Wisconsin higher education sectors provided the majority of the information reflected in these exhibits. Data was collected by HEAB through the annual Wisconsin Student Support Information System (WISSIS) survey, which is authorized by section HEA 1.02 of the State Administrative Code. The four higher education sectors in Wisconsin include the Independent Colleges and Universities, the Tribal Colleges, the University of Wisconsin System, and the Wisconsin Technical College System.

Exhibits A - H show total need-based financial aid data for all four sectors, and comparisons between the four sectors.

Exhibits I - K compare current year data to the previous 10 years.

Exhibits L - P present the need-based financial aid data for the Independent Colleges and Universities.

Need-based aid provided by the State of Wisconsin has increased from \$79,502,303 in 2004-05 to \$91,015,063 in 2006-07, an increase of \$14.5%

Total Cost - Percentage Change from Previous Year

The total cost of education continues to increase, as it has every year:

Based on the data collected, the overall cost of obtaining a higher education is increasing at a greater rate than overall need-based financial assistance.

PLEASE NOTE: The increase in the Independent Colleges and Universities is due to the total cost being more uniformly calculated for this sector in 2006-07.

The total Expected Family Contributions (EFC) also increased:

The overall increase in EFCs over the past two years is due, in part, to adjustments made by the federal Department of Education to the EFC formula in 2005, and does not, necessarily, indicate and increase in the ability of Wisconsin families to pay for higher education.

Total Need - Percentage Change from Previous Year

Financial need is determined by subtracting the EFC from the cost of education. In 2006-07, overall financial need experienced its largest increase in eight years.







Average Cost of Education / Need-Based Financial Assistance**





2006-07 FAFSA Applicants Expected Family Contribution (EFC) Comparison





the Expected Family Contribution (EFC)






Dependency Status of Need-Based Aid Recipients**









Compared to All Other Sources of Assistance**


















