Wisconsin Higher Education Grant - UW

WHEG - UW has committed 131.90% (\$35,875,305) of its appropriation with 25,638 awards. This is 3,119 more awards and 7.69% more committed than at this time last year. In 2002-03 the program had committed 124.21% of its appropriation at this time. The final commitment for 2002-03 was 135.88%.

Wisconsin Higher Education Grant - WTC

WHEG - WTC has committed 167.66% (\$24,937,133) of its appropriation with 28,928 awards. This is 436 more awards and 2.09% less committed than at this time last year. In 2002-03 the program had committed 169.75% of its appropriation at this time. The final commitment for 2002-03 was 169.97%.

Wisconsin Tuition Grant

WTG has committed 112.27% (\$24,815,204) of its appropriation with 10,757 awards. This is 970 less awards and 3.62% less committed than at this time last year. "W" and "Z" codes were implemented on August 27th, 2003. In 2002-03 the program had committed 115.89% of its appropriation at this time. The final commitment for 2002-03 was 116.73%.

Status of Applicants

The number of applicants (first-time FAFSA filers including graduate students, non-degree students and possibly non-Wisconsin residents) through October 21, 2003, for 2003-04 was 200,227. Last year at this time there were 186,042 applicants. Applicants for 2002-2003 totaled 209,276.
