Wisconsin Higher Education Grant – UW

WHEG - UW has committed 127.65% (\$55,330,522) of its appropriation with 28,096 awards. This is 79 more awards and .90% less committed than at this time last year. In 2005-06 the program had committed 128.55% of its appropriation at this time. NOTE: The appropriation recommended by the Joint Finance Committee, plus \$4,064,684 of the \$8,000,000 the Governor restored to WHEG-UW, was used to calculate the committed percentage.

Wisconsin Higher Education Grant – WTC

WHEG – WTC has committed 155.77% (\$25,991,796) of its appropriation with 30,666 awards. This is 77 fewer awards and 2.01% more committed than at this time last year. In 2005-06 the program had committed 153.76% of its appropriation at this time.

Wisconsin Tuition Grant

WTG has committed 88.45% (\$20,125,619) of its appropriation with 7547 awards. This is 2,450 fewer awards and 26.41% less committed than at this time last year. In 2005-06 the program had committed 114.86% of its appropriation at this time.

Wisconsin Higher Education Grant – Tribal

WHEG – Tribal has committed 103.80% (\$419,369) of its appropriation with 262 awards. This is 55 fewer awards and 19% more committed than at this time last year. In 2005-06 the program had committed 122.93% of its appropriation at this time.

Status of Applicants

The number of applicants (first-time FAFSA filers who listed Wisconsin as their state of legal residence) for 2006-07, through September 29, 2006, is 220,669. Last year at this time there were 214,947 applicants. Applicants for 2005-06 totaled 246,975.
