## Data from January 23, 2008

**Wisconsin Higher Education Grant – UW** WHEG - UW has committed 131.64% (\$65,821,681) of its appropriation with 30,877 awards. This is 2,013 more awards and .39% less committed than at this time last year. In 2006-07 the program had committed 131.25% of its appropriation at this time.

## **Wisconsin Higher Education Grant – WTC**

WHEG – WTC has committed 170.8% (\$29,237,228) of its appropriation with 34,039 awards. This is 951 more awards and .2.1% more committed than at this time last year. In 2006-07 the program had committed 168.58% of its appropriation at this time.

#### **Wisconsin Tuition Grant**

WTG has committed 96.84% (\$24,653,286) of its appropriation with 9,284 awards. This is 1,997 more awards and 13.13% more committed than at this time last year. In 2006-07 the program had committed 72.87% of its appropriation at this time.

# **Wisconsin Higher Education Grant – Tribal**

WHEG – Tribal has committed 120.34% (\$498,214) of its appropriation with 306 awards. This is 68 more awards and 24.91% more committed than at this time last year. In 2006-07 the program had committed 95.43% of its appropriation at this time.

### **Status of Applicants**

The number of applicants (first-time FAFSA filers who listed Wisconsin as their state of legal residence) for 2007-08, through January 22, 2008, is 250,872. Last year at this time there were 243,773 applicants. Applicants for 2006-07 totaled 254,376.
