Dear Executive Secretary Hutchison

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the Wisconsin Higher Education Grant (WHEG) formula. UW System's WHEG Advisory Committee met to discuss the current WHEG formula and to forward a recommendation for the 2009-10 funding formula for my approval.

Based on the Committee's advice and the Governor's 2009-11 budget, my recommendation is that the 2009-10 formula distribute the grant funds using a maximum expected family contribution of \$4,612, an equity level of \$6,560, and a rationing factor of 50% to increase student awards by \$300, effectively providing a hold harmless against the average projected increase in tuition for 2009-10. The maximum award will increase from \$2,980 to \$3,280, with a minimum award of \$974. Please note that this maximum grant will now exceed the \$3,000 statutory maximum for the program. Therefore, consistent with the Governor's 2009-11 proposed budget, it is essential that the statutory maximum be increased.

Thank you for working with UW System staff to develop this recommendation. I look forward to hearing your final decision following the meeting of the Higher Educational Aids Board on February 27, 2009.
