Eighty nine percent of the freshmen awarded the Academic Excellence Scholarship (AES) in 2010 accepted the scholarship and used it to attend a Wisconsin post secondary institution. The percentage of freshman who used their scholarship increased two percentage points from the previous year at eighty-seven percent. Change in legislation allowed more alternates to receive the scholarship. It may be assumed that the procedures for awarding the AES to alternates have maximized the number of scholarships used, and that an average of 88% of scholarships will be accepted by students in upcoming years.

In 2010-2011, 849 freshmen enrolled in a Wisconsin post secondary institution. Total AES funds going to these students were \$937,492 with an average per freshman award of \$1,104.

Six tables are attached, showing final figures for 2010-2011, along with preliminary data for 2011-2012.

- Tables I, II, and III present enrollment by sector (University of Wisconsin, Wisconsin Technical Colleges, and Wisconsin Independent Colleges and Universities.) These figures represent the students who received AES program funds.
- Table IV presents a grand total for the three sectors.
- Table V presents general information such as the number of scholars using their award to attend a Wisconsin college or university.
- Table VI gives preliminary information for 2011-2012 freshmen.
